

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 677

Approved by the Governor March 27, 1984

Introduced by Warner, 25

AN ACT relating to rules of the road; to amend section 39-698, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change powers of the Department of Roads relating to traffic-control devices; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-698, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

39-698. The Department of Roads shall adopt the most recent edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways as the uniform system of traffic-control devices consistent with the provisions of sections 39-601 to 39-6,122 for use upon all highways within this state, and shall issue such supplements and specifications, correlated with and so far as possible conforming to the system set forth in such manual, as may be required to implement such manual in this state and to conform with such other standards as may be issued or endorsed by the federal highway administrator. Consistent with the provisions of sections 39-601 to 39-6,122, the Department of Roads may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations adopting and implementing a manual on uniform traffic-control devices in order to provide a uniform system of traffic-control devices on all highways within this state.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-698, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
