

LEGISLATIVE BILL 703

Approved by the Governor February 24, 1984

Introduced by Chambers, 11

AN ACT relating to fees; to amend section 33-139.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to prohibit the receipt of witness and other fees by certain employees as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 33-139.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-139.01. Notwithstanding any existing provision to the contrary, ~~when whenever~~ any employee of the State of Nebraska or of any political subdivision thereof is called as a witness by the State of Nebraska or a political subdivision thereof, or when any privately employed security guard is called as a witness by his or her employer, in any action or proceeding in any court in this state in connection with his or her officially assigned duties, he or she shall not receive any witness fee, attendance fee, or mileage fee which shall be taxed as court costs in such action or proceeding, except ~~Provided~~, that he or she shall be compensated for his or her actual and necessary expenses when called as a witness by the state or political subdivision thereof and is required to travel outside of the county of his or her residence, payment to be made by the government or employer which called him or her.

Sec. 2. That original section 33-139.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
