

LEGISLATIVE BILL 980

Approved by the Governor April 3, 1984

Introduced by Beutler, 28

AN ACT relating to licenses; to amend section 81-8,133.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change a provision relating to the licensing of seconds; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 81-8,133.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-8,133.01. The State Athletic Commissioner may grant licenses to qualified physicians, managers, matchmakers, and professional boxing judges upon an application and payment of an annual fee of ten dollars and to qualified timekeepers, contestants, and seconds upon an application and payment of an annual fee of five dollars. No person shall serve as physician, manager, matchmaker, or judge at any wrestling or boxing match who is not licensed as such. No person shall serve as timekeeper, or contestant, ~~or second~~ at any professional wrestling or boxing match who is not licensed as such. The commissioner shall have summary authority to stop any match at which any person is serving in violation of the provisions of this section. Any license granted under the provisions of this section may be revoked for cause.

Sec. 2. That original section 81-8,133.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
