

LEGISLATIVE BILL 1063

Approved by the Governor April 17, 1986

Introduced by Nichol, 48

AN ACT relating to dogs; to amend section 54-614, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change the license tax; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 54-614, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

54-614. Any county having a population in excess of fifteen thousand inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census may collect a license tax in an amount which shall be determined by the appropriate governing body of not less than one dollar nor more than three dollars per dog from the owners and harborers of dogs, and enforce the same by appropriate penalties, and cause the destruction of any dog, for which the owner or harborer shall refuse or neglect to pay such license tax. Such county may regulate, license, or prohibit the running at large of dogs and guard against injuries or annoyances therefrom and authorize the destruction of the same when running at large contrary to the provisions of any regulations.

Sec. 2. That original section 54-614, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
