

LEGISLATIVE BILL 820

Approved by the Governor March 24, 1986

Introduced by V. Johnson, 8

AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-547, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to lunch periods for teachers; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-547, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

~~79-547. Every Class II, III, IV, V, and VI~~ school district shall provide each teacher with an uninterrupted lunch period of not less than thirty minutes each school day, and no teacher shall be assigned teaching, supervisory, or other duties during such lunch period, except that ~~7~~ PROVIDED, that ~~Class II or III~~ school district attendance centers ~~located outside the limits of any city or village and having less than two teachers shall be exempted from the provisions of this section.~~

Sec. 2. That original section 79-547, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
