

LEGISLATIVE BILL 564

Approved by the Governor May 29, 1987

Introduced by Schmit, 23

AN ACT relating to the Supreme Court; to amend section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1986; to change provisions relating to salary as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1986, be amended to read as follows:

24-201.01. On January 8, 1981, the salary of the Chief Justice and Judges of the Supreme Court shall be forty-eight thousand three hundred fourteen dollars and eighty cents. As soon as the same may be legally paid under the Constitution of Nebraska, the salary shall be increased to an amount equal to ~~five~~ three per cent over the salary in effect on January 1, 1986. ~~base salary.~~ For the purposes of this section, ~~base salary~~ shall mean the amount derived by increasing ~~forty-eight thousand three hundred fourteen dollars and eighty cents by five per cent.~~ On January 5, 1984 July 1, 1989, the salary shall be increased by five per cent of the salary received immediately prior to such date. On January 3, 1985 July 1, 1990, the salary shall be increased by five per cent of the salary received immediately prior to such date. ~~On January 1, 1986, the salary shall be increased by five per cent of the salary received immediately prior to such date.~~ The Chief Justice and the Judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the government of the United States for which they receive compensation for their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. That original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1986, is repealed.
