## LEGISLATIVE BILL 798

Approved by the Governor February 3, 1988

Introduced by Labedz, 5, Chairperson, Executive Board

AN ACT relating to cities of the primary class; to amend section 15-844, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to eliminate a reference to a section of the Nebraska Constitution that was repealed in 1972; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 15-844, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

15-844. Land, buildings, money, debts due the city, and real and personal property, and assets of every kind and description belonging to any city of the primary class shall be exempt from taxation, except as previded by Artiele XV, section 16, of the Constitution of Nebraska, and shall also be exempt from execution, liens, and sale. Judgments against the said a city of the primary class shall be paid out of the judgment fund, or out of a special fund created for that purpose.

Sec. 2. That original section 15-844, Reissue

Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
