

LEGISLATIVE BILL 1105

Approved by the Governor March 13, 1990

Introduced by Haberman, 44

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska State Patrolmen's Retirement System; to provide an election to repay the system upon reemployment as prescribed; to provide a duty for the Revisor of Statutes; and to provide an operative date.  
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. From January 1, 1991, to June 30, 1991, any person who withdrew his or her accumulated contributions pursuant to subsection (1) of section 81-2031 prior to the operative date of this act and has again become an employee of the Nebraska State Patrol may elect to repay the retirement system for any number of years of service which he or she accumulated prior to withdrawing his or her accumulated contributions. The amount to be repaid shall not exceed the amount of the withdrawal for the years of service for which the repayment is being made plus the interest which would have accrued on that amount under the retirement system. Any person who repays such amount shall be restored to the same status for the years of service for which repayment is made as he or she had prior to the withdrawal of the accumulated contributions. This section shall not apply to employees of the Nebraska State Patrol retiring prior to the operative date of this act.

Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of this act within sections 81-2014 to 81-2034. Any reference to sections 81-2014 to 81-2034 shall be construed to include section 1 of this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall become operative on January 1, 1991.
