AN ACT relating to workers' compensation; to amend section 48-186, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change a provision relating to the location of certain hearings; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

That section 48-186, Reissue Section 1. Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

48-186. In all cases when the accident occurred outside of the State of Nebraska, the hearing before a judge of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court shall be at Lincoln, Nebraska, or in any other county in the state at the discretion of the compensation court, unless otherwise stipulated by the parties at least fourteen days before the date of hearing.

Sec. 2. That original section 48-186, Reissue

Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
