

LEGISLATIVE BILL 893

Approved by the Governor February 24, 1990

Introduced by Lynch, 13

AN ACT relating to counties; to amend section 23-1112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change the mileage rate allowed county officers as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 23-1112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

23-1112. (1) When it is necessary for any county officer or his or her deputy or assistants, except any county sheriff or his or her deputy, to travel on business of the county, he or she shall be allowed mileage at the rate of twenty-four ~~twenty~~ and one-half cents per mile for each mile actually and necessarily traveled by the most direct route if the trip or trips ~~be are~~ made by automobile, but if travel by rail or bus ~~shall be~~ is economical and practical, he or she shall be allowed only the actual cost of rail or bus transportation, upon the presentation of his or her bill for the same accompanied by a proper voucher to the county board of his or her county in like manner as is provided for as to all other claims against the county.

(2) Any future adjustments made to the reimbursement rate provided in subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to apply to all provisions of law which refer to this section for the computation of mileage.

Sec. 2. That original section 23-1112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
