## LEGISLATIVE BILL 958

relating to rules of the road; to amend section AN ACT 39-6,103.01, Reissue Revised Statutes Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating the required use of child passenger restraint systems and seat safety belts; to provide a duty for the Department of Motor Vehicles; and to repeal the original section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

That section 39-6,103.01, Reissue Section 1. Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to as follows:

(1) Any person, who resides in 39-6,103.01. Nebraska and drives any motor vehicle which has or is required to have seat safety belts, shall ensure that (a) all children under the age of four or weighing less than forty pounds being transported in such vehicle use a child passenger restraint system, of a type which meets Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 213 as Safety developed by the National Highway Traffic Administration as of August 26, 1983, or use a seat safety belt for children over age one the effective date of this act and which is correctly installed in such vehicle and (b) all children weighing forty or more pounds or at least four years of age and younger than five years of age being transported in such vehicle use a seat safety belt.

This subsection shall apply to every motor hich is equipped with seat safety belts or is vehicle which is equipped with seat safety belts or is required to be equipped with restraint systems pursuant to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 208 except taxicabs, mopeds, motorcycles, and any motor vehicle designated by the manufacturer as a 1963 year model or earlier which is not equipped with a seat safety belt.

Whenever any physician (2) medicine in Nebraska determines, through practice accepted medical procedures, that use of a passenger restraint system by a particular child would be harmful by reason of the child's weight, physical condition, or other medical reason, the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be waived. driver of any vehicle transporting such a child shall LB 958

carry on his or her person or in the vehicle a signed written statement of the physician identifying the child and stating the grounds for such waiver.

(3) The drivers of authorized emergency vehicles, as defined in section 39-602, shall not be subject to the requirements of subsection (1) of this section when operating such authorized emergency vehicles pursuant to their employment.

(4) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall develop and implement an ongoing public information and education program regarding the use of child passenger

restraint systems and seat safety belts.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-6,103.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
