LEGISLATIVE BILL 280

Approved by the Governor May 4, 1993

Introduced by Moore, 24

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Arts Council; to amend section 82-313, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to provide an additional power for the council; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 82-313, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

82-313. The council Nebraska Arts Council may (1) hold public and private hearings, (2) enter into contracts, within the limit of funds available therefor, with individuals, organizations, and institutions for services furthering the educational objectives of the council's programs, (3) enter into contracts, within the limit of funds available therefor, with local and regional associations for cooperative endeavors furthering the educational objectives of the council's programs, (4) accept gifts, contributions, and bequests of unrestricted funds from individuals, foundations, corporations, and other organizations or institutions for the purpose of furthering the educational objectives of the council's programs, (5) distribute funds appropriated by the Legislature to any organization which has been designated as the state affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities for the period covered by the appropriation, and (5) (6) make and sign any agreements and do and perform any acts that may be necessary to carry out the purposes of sections 82-309 to 82-315 82-316. The council may request from any department, division, board, bureau, commission, or agency of the state such assistance and data as will enable it properly to carry out its powers and duties.

Sec. 2. That original section 82-313, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
