AN ACT relating to court fees; to amend section 33-107.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change fee provisions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 33-107.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

33-107.02. (1) A docket fee of fifteen dollars shall be collected by the clerk of the county court or the clerk of the district court for each proceeding to modify a decree of dissolution or annulment of marriage, a modification of an award of child support, or a modification of child custody or visitation. Such fees shall be remitted to the State Treasurer on forms provided prescribed by the State Treasurer within ten days after the close of each month for credit to the Legal Aid and Services Fund.

(2) Any proceeding filed by a county attorney or an authorized attorney, as defined in section 43-1704, in a case in which services are being provided under Title IV-D of the federal Social Security Act, as amended, shall not be subject to the provisions of this section.

Sec. 2. Original section 33-107.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
