1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to game and parks; to amend section 37-913,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to transfer funds as
3 prescribed; to provide requirements on the use of certain funds; to
4 eliminate the Nebraska Youth Conservation Program and a fund; to
5 repeal the original section; and to outright repeal sections 37-915,
6 37-916, 37-917, 37-918, 37-919, 37-920, and 37-921, Revised Statutes
7 Cumulative Supplement, 2014.
8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 37-913, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 37-913 (1) There is hereby created the Cowboy Trail Fund. Any money
4 in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state
5 investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the
6 Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

7 (2) Money accepted or transferred pursuant to subsection (3) of
8 section 37-912 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
9 fund.

10 (3) The State Treasurer shall transfer any money in the Nebraska
11 Youth Conservation Program Fund on the effective date of this act to the
12 Cowboy Trail Fund. The Game and Parks Commission shall use the money
13 transferred under this subsection for purposes of the Cowboy Trail. The
14 commission shall use money transferred to the Cowboy Trail Fund under
15 this subsection for the development of undeveloped portions of the Cowboy
16 Trail but shall not expend any money under this subsection unless the
17 amount is matched both by a public entity and by a private entity for
18 each expenditure.

19 Sec. 2. Original section 37-913, Reissue Revised Statutes of
20 Nebraska, is repealed.

21 Sec. 3. The following sections are outright repealed: Sections
22 37-915, 37-916, 37-917, 37-918, 37-919, 37-920, and 37-921, Revised
