This bill would change provisions relating to sealing of juvenile criminal justice records. It outright repeals the following sections:

- 43-2,102 Setting aside adjudication; when.
- 43-2,103 Setting aside adjudication; factors considered.
- 43-2,104 Setting aside adjudication; hearing; order.
- 43-2,105 Setting aside adjudication; records, sealed; notice of hearing; violation; contempt.

The Nebraska Department of Labor and the Department of Health and Human Services estimate no fiscal impact.

The Supreme Court states that this bill could increase county court workload related to sealing juvenile records. Any increase in expenditures is not estimated to be significant.
