LB 502 amends the Nebraska Workforce Investment Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 48-1617, 48-1623, and 48-1624.

Section 48-1617 is amended to include health care workers in its reference to workforce in the statute's intent language.

Section 48-1623 is amended to add a representative of health care employers who conduct statewide health workforce planning and training to the Workforce Investment Board.

The Department of Labor has indicated that at this time the Board has two representatives from the health care field. Depending on what sector the additional representative comes from, this could create the need to add an additional member from the business sector under subdivision (2)(c)(i) of Section 48-1623 to maintain the at least 51 percent majority required by the statute.

The Department estimates an expenditure of \$6,500 for travel and expenses for an additional member of the Board from federal funds. There is no General Fund impact.

There is no basis to disagree with the Department of Labor's estimate of fiscal impact.
