Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would change a provision relating to juror disqualification.

Currently, a person is disqualified to be a juror if such a person has been convicted of a criminal offense, punishable by imprisonment in a Department of Correctional Services adult correctional facility. This bill would strike that language and replace it by stating that a person is disqualified to be a juror if such a person has been convicted of a "felony offense".

It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the state or political subdivisions.
