Explanation of Estimate:

LB 879 would allow for Nebraska Public School system personnel to apply for a concealed carry weapon permit to be utilized on school property. The Nebraska State Patrol has provided a range of Expenditures and Revenues for FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16 based on the assumption that a given percentage of employees will apply for such permits. The above estimates assume a range of 10%-50% for FY 2014-15, and a range of 10%-25% for FY 2015-16. The base of 42,000 employees within the Nebraska Public School System was utilized in arriving at estimated permits that range in number from 4,200 at 10%, 21,000 at 50%, and 10,500 permits at 25%. Revenues were projected based upon the above mentioned ranges at \$125 per permit. Additional Agency FTE's needed to process this increase in volume are estimated to be 3.5 at 10%, 13.5 at 50%, and 7.25 at 25%. In addition to some up-front capital outlays for technology and workstations, there is also an operating expense for fees that must be paid to the FBI at \$14.50 per permit for background checks.
