LB 1052 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.

The bill amends Section 53-183 to allow a licensed retailer engaged in the selling of distilled spirits to issue tasting cards to their customers.

Current law allows a licensed retailer engaged in the sale of wine to issue tasting cards to their customers.

The Liquor Control Commission indicates they have no basis to project any impact.

There appears to be minimal fiscal impact as a result of LB 1052.
