Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 48 designates three acts that will be considered unfair trade practices in the business of insurance. The three acts are: refusing to issue or renew, canceling or limiting the amount of property and casualty coverage due to weather-related casualties under a homeowner's policy unless the insured failed to make certain repairs for prior weather related casualties within a specified or reasonable time; surcharging an insured for a property and casualty loss on which the insurer did not pay a claim; and, surcharging an insured for a property and casualty loss due to weather-related casualties to previously occupied or noncovered property.

Persons who are determined to have engaged in an unfair trade practice by the Director of the Department of Insurance may be fined up to \$1,000 for each violation, not to exceed an aggregate penalty of \$30,000. Penalties for flagrant violations are up to \$15,000 per violation, not to exceed \$150,000 in the aggregate. The number of violations and assessed penalties pursuant to the bill is unknown, but projected to be small. Any revenue received from penalties is deposited in the Permanent School Fund, from which the interest accrues to public schools on an annual basis.
