Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 494 amends Nebraska Revised Statutes, Section 48-1203 regarding the minimum hourly wage.

The bill adds new language to the statute increasing the hourly wage for persons compensated by gratuities. The current statutory rate is \$2.13 per hour. The bill requires the wage to increase to \$3.00 per hour beginning on the effective date of the bill for a one-year period of time. For each succeeding one-year period, additional increases are required each year in order to provide those employees compensated by gratuities with a minimum wage that is 50% of the state minimum wage.

Assuming the effective date of LB 494 is early September 2015, the wage would become \$3.00 per hour at that time and continue at that level until September 2016, when it would become \$3.95 per hour for a one-year period. In September 2017 the wage would become \$4.50 per hour, which would be 50% of the regular state minimum wage then in effect.

The state minimum wage (for employees not compensated by gratuities) increased to \$8.00 on January 1, 2015 and will increase to \$9.00 on January 1, 2016.

The Department of Labor, the Department of Administrative Services, and the Nebraska Library Commission all indicate no fiscal impact as a result of LB 494.

We agree with the agencies estimate of fiscal impact.
