Explanation of Estimate: This program supports UNMC's BHECN (the Behavioral Health Education Center of Nebraska at UNMC) and MMI (Munroe-Meyer Institute) in providing advanced intercampus BH internship training (with UN-K, Wayne State, UN-L, UN-O, Chadron State and private MA programs). Targeted will be Mental Health (Counseling, Marriage and Family, and Social Work) Master's degree students. Training and internship support will prepare students to work in Integrated Primary Care Medical clinics across the State. BHECN's mission is to develop the BH workforce in Nebraska and this program will complement current training stipend supports being provided for psychiatry residents (MDs) and psychology interns (PhDs). The program will emphasize a rural focus and opportunities for BH students to remain in Nebraska and meet critical MH needs. BHECN and MMI will offer an Advanced Certificate in Integrated BH Care and will provide and/or contract for required supervision hours in any of 19 rural and 13 urban Integrated Care clinics currently collaborating with UNMC. BH Trainees will apply to BHECN for the program and 12 per year will be accepted, Trainees will participate in required advanced training in the Integrated Primary Care Certificate program, and be assigned to experienced clinicians for their 600 to 900 hour required applied internship/practicum experiences. Collaboration with Nebraska University and College training programs has been established and is also supported by Nebraska professional organizations including the Nebraska chapters of BH professionals from Marriage and Family Therapy, Counseling, and Social Work. Funding and program management will flow through UNMC's BHECN and MMI programs.
