Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill requires interpreters for the deaf and hard of hearing to be licensed beginning on January 1, 2016. A person who is on the roster of qualified interpreters on or before January 1, 2016, may be issued a license upon filing an application and paying the fee. The license fees are set by the Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing. Violations of the licensing requirements would be subject to a civil penalty.

The Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing estimates revenue of \$9,000 in FY 16 based on the current fee of \$150. There would be an increase in cash fund expenditures of \$9,000 also.

Explanation of Estimate: The intent of LB287 is to require community interpreters and providers to hold a license. This would allow NCDHH to monitor efficiency and competency of interpreters as well as regulate complaints. It is estimated that there are 47 interpreters and 13 businesses that would fall under LB287. The exact licensing fees are unknown because they are set by the Board, however; if they are consistent with the current licensing fees it would be \$150 per application.
