Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 531 requires the Department of Insurance (DOI) to ensure that web sites maintained by state agencies for the sale of health insurance provide links to internet-based tools and calculators to assist buyers in accessing information needed to make informed purchasing decisions. The bill also requires the DOI to monitor insurance companies to ensure that health insurers offering plans and policies for sale in the state post information specified in the bill on their websites and make the information available to the public and insureds.

The DOI projects the need for a Health Analyst II to implement the requirements of the bill. The estimated increase in cash fund expenditures for the additional employee and related operating expenses is \$53,573 in FY16 and \$52,722 in FY17.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB531 would provide requirements for publication of information relating to health insurance policies, health plans, and health maintenance organization subscriptions that are sold or offered for sale to individuals. State plans are offered to employees at a cost, but It is unclear if this would be considered a sale under this bill; thus it is unclear whether LB531 would apply to employer group health insurance plans.

Should LB531 apply to the State of Nebraska's health insurance plan, there would be no fiscal impact. AS- Personnel-Wellness & Benefits would work with the State's third-party administrator to assure the plan information provided to plan participants complies with the requirements set forth in the bill.

These new duties are not currently performed by the Department.

A Health Analyst II would be required by the Department to perform these new duties.
