LB 856 is the Internet Neutrality Act.

Section 4 provides that an Internet service provider (ISP) shall not provide any fixed or mobile broadband Internet access service that is not in full compliance with the Act.

Section 5 requires ISPs to publicly disclose accurate information regarding the network management practices, performance and commercial terms of their broadband Internet access service sufficient for users to be able to fully and accurately determine if the service is in compliance with the Act.

Section 6 prohibits ISPs from blocking lawful content, applications, services, or nonharmful devices, subject to reasonable network management.

Section 7 prohibits ISPs from impairing or degrading lawful Internet traffic on the basis of content, application, or service or use of a nonharmful device, subject to reasonable network management.

Section 8 prohibits ISPs from engaging in paid prioritization as to a particular broadband Internet access service unless the ISP demonstrates that the practice would provide some significant public interest benefit and would not harm the open nature of such service.

Section 9 prohibits ISPs from unreasonably interfering with or unreasonably disadvantaging (1) the ability of users to select, access, or use broadband Internet access service, lawful content, application, or service, or devices of their choice or (2) the ability of edge providers to make lawful content, application, service, or devices available to users of such service. Reasonable network management shall not be considered a violation of this section.
